Educational Requirements

Must have graduated from an accredited school of nursing, hold a current state license and have a minimum of one year of hospital experience within the last two years.

General Summary

The RN coordinates the care of patient/families from admission to discharge with consideration of the aging process, human development stages and cultural patterns. The RN assists, teaches and counsels the patient and family in making decisions related to their care. They utilize the nursing process (assessment, diagnosis, planning, intervention and evaluation) as the structured mechanism for critical thinking. He/she collaborates with members of the healthcare team in designing, coordinating and carrying out the plan of care and documents accordingly in regards to policy and procedure. All RN's are accountable to the clinical manager.
